## Nashua School Board of Trustees Resolution of Intent to Impose an Increase in Levies Fiscal Year 2024

As an essential part of its budgeting process, the Nashua School Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. Senate Bill 307 requires the District to provide notice of its intent to increase non-voted levies in the ensuing fiscal year. The Nashua School Board of Trustees estimates the following increases/decreases in revenues and mills for funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district:
