Nashua Alumni Scholarship

The Nashua Alumni Memorial Scholarship is available to graduates of Nashua High School who are currently enrolled in a post-secondary education program. The monies distributed for this scholarship may be one scholarship of \$300, two scholarships of \$150, or three scholarship of \$100.

Qualifications and Requirements:

1. Must be a graduate of Nashua High School.

2. Must be a full-time student enrolled at an accredited college, university, or vocational technical institution with the status of sophomore or above.
3. Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or better.
4. Scholarship money must be spent at an accredited college, university, or vocational technical institution of higher learning.

Application Instructions:

1. Complete the scholarship application form.
2. Submit a complete college transcript that includes your cumulative GPA and number of credits earned.
3. Submit one letter of recommendation from a college contact, clergy, or employer(not related to applicant) who is familiar with your character.

The Nashua Community Club dissolved in approximately 1987. The club gave their scholarship monies to the Lucky Clover 4-H Club to be disbursed to students pursuing a post-secondary education. On April 14, 1997, Lucky Clover 4-H Club turned over their scholarship monies to Nashua School to award one scholarship entitled Nashua Community Scholarship in the amount of \$150.

8. Scholarship money must be spent at an accredited college, university, or vocational technical institution of higher learning.
